

Application for Residential Electric HVAC Rebates

Requirements for Application

- Determine Eligibility:** Any existing residential premise with an active Vectren Energy Delivery of Indiana electric service account is eligible. Customers with gas service available or adjacent to their property, or those installing dual fuel air source heat pumps, are eligible for a reduced incentive.
- Install Equipment:** New equipment must be installed and old equipment must be removed and disposed of. Equipment must be purchased and installed between October 1, 2011 and December 31, 2013. Qualifying equipment lists can be found at <http://www.ceedirectory.org/>.
- Complete and sign the application.** All applicable fields must be completed on the form to receive a rebate, including installation address. **THE REBATE FORM AND INVOICE(S) MUST BE POSTMARKED WITHIN 60 DAYS OF THE PRODUCT PURCHASE.** Please allow up to eight (8) weeks to receive your rebate. Incomplete rebate forms will not be processed.
- Include the following documentation** with your rebate application:
 - A copy of the customer's invoice(s) listing the model number(s), date of installation, installation address, and total project cost of the equipment being submitted for a rebate.
 - AHRI Certificate of Product Ratings for the installed equipment.

Vectren Energy Delivery of Indiana reserves the right to alter or discontinue the rebate offers at any time without notice. Rebate funds are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

General Eligibility

Visit <http://www.ceedirectory.org/> for a current list of qualifying equipment. Applicant must be a Vectren Energy Delivery of Indiana electric residential customer and the location of the installed equipment must have Vectren residential electrical service. Customers with Vectren Natural Gas service on or adjacent to their property are not eligible for the full Heat Pump Incentive. Customers installing dual fuel air source heat pumps and customers with gas service on or adjacent to their property will receive a reduced incentive.

Compliance

All projects must comply with applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations, including building codes. All equipment must be new or retrofitted with new components which meet the program specifications. Used or rebuilt equipment is not eligible for incentives. Existing equipment must be removed or permanently disconnected. All projects must be a retrofit/replacement installation in an existing building. Customers may not apply for both Vectren Residential New Construction Program incentive and Residential Electric HVAC Program incentives.

Application Delivery

A complete, signed application, itemized invoices for materials and labor must be submitted at the address located on the cover page of this application within 60 days of project completion. The invoice(s) must indicate the date of purchase, size, type, make, model and total project cost. AHRI Certificates of Product Ratings must also be included. In cases where the AHRI Certificate of Product Ratings is not available or applicable, the original equipment manufacturer (OEM) specification sheets must also be included. Please keep a copy for your records.

Payment

Please allow up to eight (8) weeks to receive your rebate. Incomplete rebate forms will not be processed.

Verification

Vectren Energy Delivery of Indiana reserves the right to verify sales receipts and/or installations of products before issuing rebates. A random inspection may be conducted to verify installations.
